

AUSTRALIAN PRODUCTION STATISTICS
 PRODUCTION SUMMARY NO. 10A: ASSEMBLY OF MOTOR VEHICLE CHASSIS

NOVEMBER, 1963.

The information set out below has been compiled from returns received from all factories engaged in the assembly of motor vehicle chassis. For the purpose of these statistics "Chassis" comprise (a) complete chassis ready to drive away without body but including front fenders and engine cover, and (b) chassis units of monoconstructed vehicles, in which case floor or side plates, actually replacing parts of the chassis frame (such as side and cross members) are considered as parts of the monoconstructed chassis. These statistics do NOT include assembled chassis imported as such. Figures for 1962-63 and 1963-64 are subject to revision.
