Main price changes between April 1980 and May 1980:

Milk prices increased in Melbourne, Adelaide and Perth. Prices of fresh fruit and vegetables increased in all cities except Brisbane and Canberra.

Prices of meals out and take-away food increased in all cities.

Beef prices increased in Adelaide and Canberra, and fell in Hobart.

Lamb prices increased in Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth and fell in Canberra.

### Collection of prices

3. Prices for food items are collected as at the middle of each month except in the case of some fresh items (fruit, vegetables and fish) where prices are collected more frequently and averaged to obtain monthly prices.

### Index points and percentage changes

4. Movements in indexes from one period to another can be expressed either as percentage changes, or as changes in 'index points'. The difference between these two methods of describing movements in indexes is shown by the following example:

*Food Group: Weighted average of six State capital cities*

#### Index numbers

May 1980	296.2
Less: April 1980	293.4
Change in index points	+2.8

$$\text{Percentage change} = \frac{+2.8}{293.4} \times 100 = +1.0\%$$

### Interpretation of results

5. Month-to-month price changes should not be interpreted in isolation and without reference to changes over longer periods, mainly because prices of fresh food items are subject to large short term fluctuations. Frequently these fluctuations are also the main cause of disparate movements in the indexes for various cities.

6. The capital city indexes measure price movements over time in each city individually. They do not measure differences in retail price levels between cities. Average retail prices of selected items in the various capital cities are shown in publication Catalogue No. 6403.0 (see paragraph 10).

7. Table 4 provides a detailed analysis of recent price movements in the Food Group index. It shows index numbers and percentage changes for subgroups and other groupings within the Food Group. Table 4 also shows the contribution which each subgroup makes to the total CPI. These are expressed in terms of 'All Groups index points'. For instance, in May 1980 the Dairy produce subgroup contributed 6.13 index points out of a total of 67.02 index points for the Food Group for the weighted average of six State capital cities. ### EXPLANATORY NOTES

#### Introduction

This publication contains monthly index numbers for the Food Group of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) and for component subgroups of the Food Group. The Food Group is the only group of the CPI for which prices are collected monthly. Quarterly index numbers for the All Groups CPI and its groups and subgroups (including the Food Group) are published in the quarterly publication *Consumer Price Index* (6401.0). Detailed information about the CPI is presented in that publication.

2. The Food Group currently contributes approximately 20 per cent to the total CPI (ninth series) aggregate for the weighted average of six State capital cities.

in All Groups index points, by each of the subgroups and groupings.

8. Any discrepancies between totals and sums of components in Table 4 are due to rounding. For similar reasons monthly movements shown by subgroup or group index numbers do not necessarily correspond exactly with those shown by the relevant index points.

9. Table 3 summarises the contributions (in terms of 'All Groups index points') which the Food Group makes to the total CPI in recent months. The figure of 67.02 for May 1980, for the weighted average of six State capital cities, indicates that the Food Group would contribute this amount to the quarterly All Groups CPI if food prices were to stand at this level for each month of the quarter.
