AUSTRALIAN OVERSEA TRADE : JUNE, 1966
RECORDED TRADE EXCLUDING BULLION AND SPECIE (PRELIMINARY)

This preliminary statement of Oversea Trade is approximate and will be followed by the Monthly Statement of Imports by Commodity Divisions and Monthly Bulletin of Oversea Trade Statistics containing details of merchandise and non-merchandise trade.

Imports and Exports are recorded statistically in the month in which the entries are passed by the Department of Customs and Excise. Normally this is within a few days of discharge or shipment of cargoes.

Recorded Imports excluding bullion and specie in June, 1966 were valued at \$A228.6 million compared with \$A269.1 million in June, 1965 a decrease of \$A40.5 million.

Recorded Exports excluding bullion and specie in June, 1966 amounted to \$A259.4 million, compared with \$A232.6 million in June, 1965 an increase of \$A26.8 million.

In June, 1966, the recorded excess of exports over imports was \$A30.8 million, compared with an excess of imports over exports of \$A36.5 million in June, 1965.

For the twelve months ended June 1965-66 recorded imports exceeded recorded exports by \$A229.1 million compared with \$A269.6 million in the corresponding period of 1964-65.

All amounts are shown in decimal currency (1 pound = 2 dollars).

"Merchandise Trade" has been redefined and details are published in the Monthly Oversea Trade Bulletin. (b) Preliminary, subject to revision. (c) Includes "H.M.A.S. Perth" valued at \$A38.9 million.

NOTE.- Freight and insurance payable on imports are not included above. These are estimated at approximately \$A180 million for six months ended 31st December, 1965.

Statistics relating to Oversea Trade do not measure Australia's total balance of payments during the period shown. Particulars of other transactions entering into the balance of payments, for example, freight charges and overseas travel, payments of dividends, profits and interest, and government expenditure overseas, are provided in the Statistical Bulletin "Balance of Payments : Quarterly Summary" issued by the Commonwealth Statistician. For items such as merchant vessels trading overseas, aircraft for use on overseas routes and certain materials for intergovernmental defence projects, no customs entries are recorded, but these transactions are taken into account in estimates of the balance of payments.
