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STATISTICAL BULLETIN - THE MEAT INDUSTRY, AUSTRALIA - MARCH, 1963

The statistics on slaughtering and meat production included in this bulletin are based on a monthly collection from abattoirs and other major slaughtering establishments, and include estimates of animals slaughtered on farms and by country butchers. They relate only to slaughtering for human consumption and do not include animals condemned or those killed for boiling down. Final results of the census of all slaughtering establishments (condensed annually) are shown, generally details from July, 1962, are subject to amendment.

In March, 1963, slaughtering of all classes of livestock were higher than in the previous month, but all except cattle were at a lower level than in the same month of the previous year.

The total carcass weight of meat produced in Australia during March, 1963, at 133,400 tons, showed an increase of 8.8% tone (1.1 per cent. lower the previous month, and 4,500 tons (3.5 per cent.) over March, 1962.

Further details of slaughtering and meat production are given in the following tables, together with information on bones of ham and canned meat production, exports of fresh and frozen and processed meat and stocks of frozen meat.
